EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This item is an administrative item for Ordinance No. 2022-1216 which was proposed to the Imperial Beach voters at the November 8, 2022 election as Measure "R," to be officially adopted pursuant to the declared and certified vote of the results for the November election which shows that voters approved Measure "R."

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council conducts the second reading/adoption of Ordinance No. 2022-1216 pursuant to the City Council's previous action to approve a resolution which certified and declared the results of the voters of Imperial Beach at the November 8, 2022 election.

OPTIONS:

Conduct second reading/adoption of Ordinance 2022-1216 approved by the voters.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

As shown in the statement of election results adopted by the City Council in the previous agenda item and resolution, the voters in Imperial Beach approved Ordinance 2022-1216. Pursuant to Elections Code section 9217, the ordinance is considered adopted upon the date that the November 8, 2022 election vote is declared by the City Council, and the votes show that a majority approved the measure. The ordinance then takes effect ten days after it is adopted.

The purpose of this ordinance is to increase the City's transient occupancy tax ("TOT") rate from the existing 10 percent to 14 percent effective January 1, 2023 for General Fund purposes.
