## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF IMPERIAL BEACH, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A TENTATIVE AGREEMENT FOR A SUCCESSOR MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF IMPERIAL BEACH AND THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES' INTERNATIONAL UNION (SEIU), LOCAL 221

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial Beach ("City") endeavors to recruit and retain the most qualified and talented employees to serve its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the salaries and benefits offered by the City to its employees are designated to aid in the City's recruitment and retention efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the past Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the City and the Service Employees' International Union (SEIU), Local 22, adopted by the City Council Resolution No. 2021-68 covering period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS,** the City and SEIU have met and confer in good faith and have come to a Tentative Agreement on a fair and equitable package of total compensation for a successor SEIU MOU for the period of Jul 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025, pursuant to the Meyers-Millias-Brown Act ("MMBA"); and

**WHEREAS,** the members of SEIU have voted to ratify the Tentative Agreement and the labor representatives of the City and SEIU have executed the Tentative Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the MMBA provides in Section 3505.1:

"If a tentative agreement is reached by the authorized representatives of the public agency and a recognized employee organization or recognized employee organizations, the governing body shall vote to accept or reject the tentative agreement within 30 days of the date it is first considered at a duly noticed public meeting. A decision by the governing body to reject the tentative agreement shall not bar the filling of a charge of unfair practice for failure to meet and confer in good faith. If the governing body adopts the tentative agreement, the parties shall jointly prepare a written memorandum of understanding."

WHEREAS, once the City Council adopts the Tentative Agreement, the parties are required to jointly prepare a written MOU to present to City Council at a later date for consideration and adoption consistent with the Tentative Agreement; and

**WHEREAS,** once approved by the city Council, the Tentative Agreement and the successor SEIU MOU 2023-2025 become biding agreements between the parties, each in their own right; and

**WHEREAS,** upon City Council approval of the Tentative Agreement, the salary and benefit changes outlined therein shall be incorporated into the annual operating budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and 2024-2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to approve the Tentative Agreement for the successor SEIU MOU 2023-2025.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the City of Imperial Beach, as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 2. The executed Tentative Agreement for a successor SEIU MOU for the period of July 1, 2023 June 30, 2025, a fully executed copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, is accepted, approved, and adopted.
- The labor representatives of the City and SEIU are directed to jointly prepare a written MOU in accordance with the Tentative Agreement and present same to City Council at a future date for its consideration and approval.
- 4. The Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 operating budget shall be amended as necessary to reflect the increased compensation and benefits authorized by the adoption of the Tentative Agreement for a successor SEIU MOU 2023-2025 and any needed appropriations shall be brought back to City Council for formal approval and adoption.
